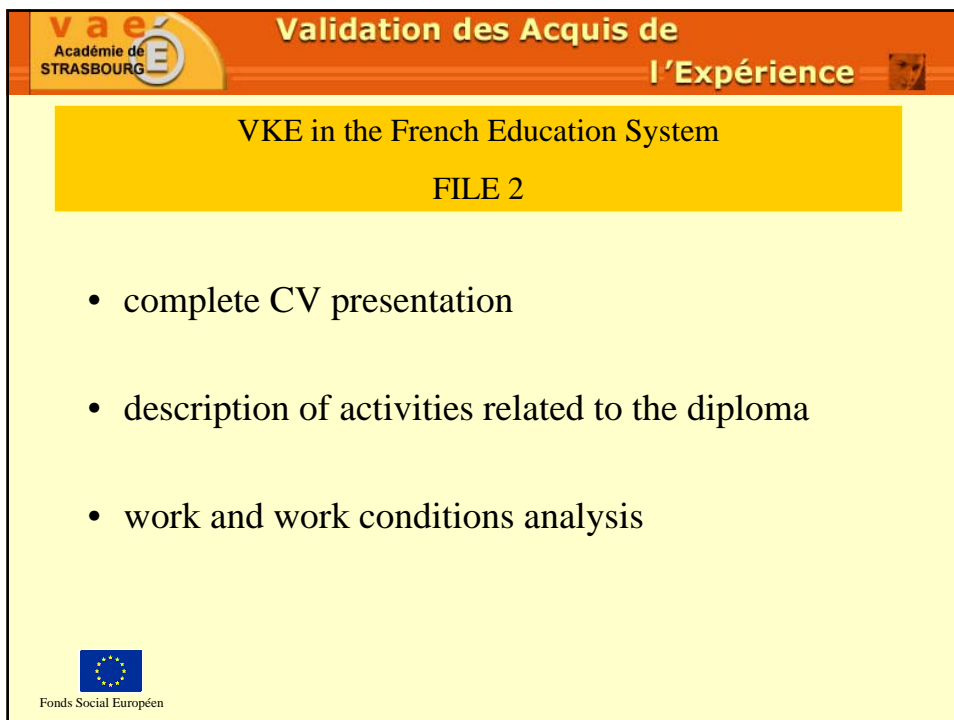
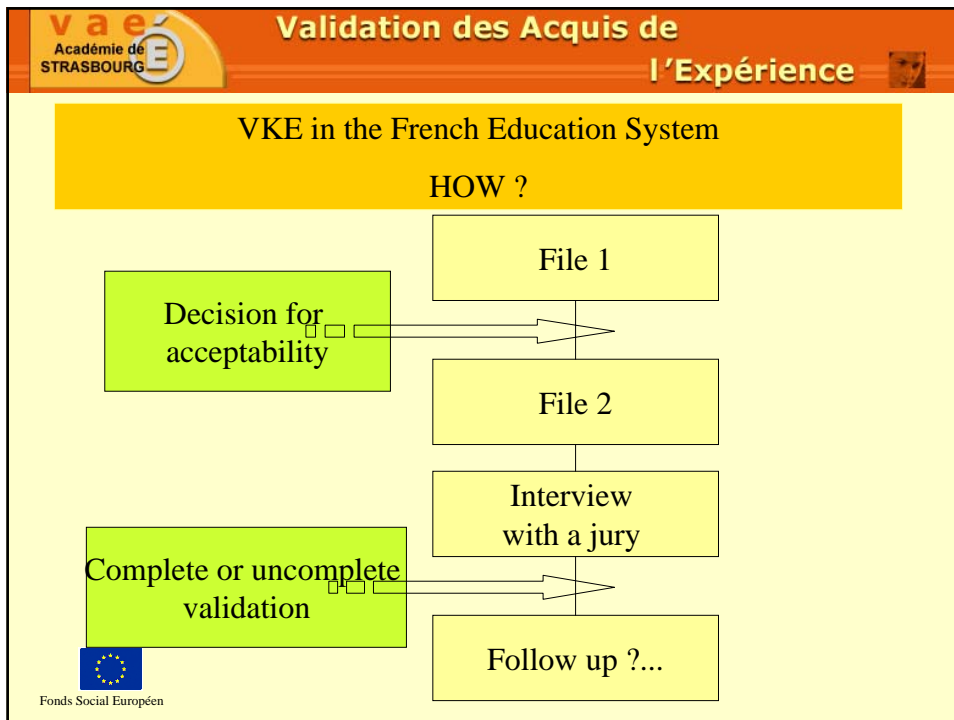
ACCESS REQUIREMENTS

- the jury decides to validate the diploma totally, partly or not at all

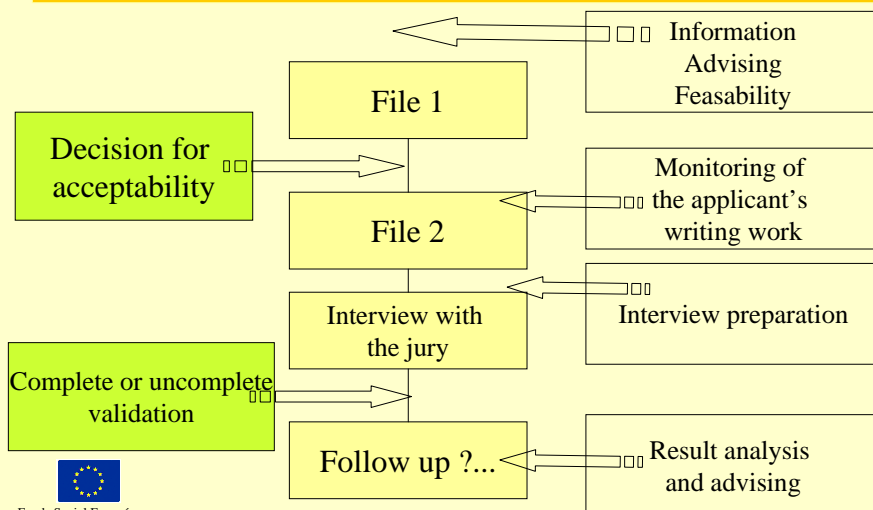

VALIDATION COUNSELLORS' ROLE

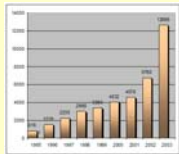
